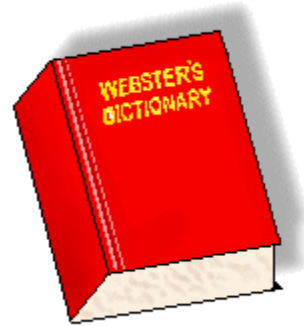

Lorain Rotary Board Minutes – December 9, 2009

President Mike called the meeting to order at 7:37 A.M.

A motion to accept the minutes of the November 11, 2009 minutes as presented was made by Sandy Kaiser seconded by Tony Cuevas and carried.

Treasurer's Report: Carolyn Huston presented the Treasurer's Report for November. Trivia Event brought in over \$28,251 in revenue with expenses so far of \$13,723.76. A motion to accept the Treasurer's

Report as presented was made by Tom Boyer, seconded by Tony Cuevas and carried. A discussion took place regarding the Directors & Officers Liability and Crime Policy the club has purchased, in the past, from Huggins Insurance. As the club is paying Rotary International for insurance, it was agreed that additional coverage will not be purchased from Huggins Insurance.

Board Nominations: Dina Ferrer has agreed to take on the role of President for the year 2011-2012. A committee will

have board nominations to present to the club on Thursday, December 10th.
