(Please note that there is not a Spouse/Partner Program at District PETS.)

While all incoming club presidents and their spouses or partners are welcome to attend All Ohio PETS in Columbus beginning on the evening of March 10, **past club presidents may be excused from attendance** after speaking with District Trainer <u>Ken Robinson</u> or me. **Remember, the entire team must attend District PETS at SourcePoint no matter how many times you've been president!**

All Ohio PETS officially kicks off with a social hour at 5:00 at the Columbus Marriott Renaissance Hotel, 50 North Third Street in Downtown Columbus! Click <u>HERE</u> to register for All Ohio PETS using your DacDb login. Note that you will register for the conference in one transaction and then be prompted to register for your hotel room separately. Your special Rotary rate will be automatically applied for you.

If there is an unresolvable conflict that prevents your attendance in Columbus and you have not previously served as president, please contact me directly as soon as possible so we can find an alternate PETS for you to attend elsewhere in the Midwest!

In closing, remember that as a Rotary Club President yours is the most important position in Rotary! Frequently Asked Questions

What do I need to do ahead of time?

- Register for District PETS <u>HERE</u>.
- Register yourself and your spouse/partner for All Ohio PETS <u>HERE</u>.
- Make sure you've registered for your hotel room at our special Rotary rate <u>HERE</u>.

What do I need to bring?

- Your Presidents Binder which includes:
 - Your Goals Worksheet. Have your initial goals completed so we can discuss them together!
 - Lead Your Club: President Manual
 - We'll discuss open questions from your "homework." *Remember, I'm a retired teacher!*
- Business Cards
 - You'll be connecting with fellow presidents elect from all over Ohio.
 - Click <u>HERE</u> for a template you can download, complete, and send to a local printer or online service. Here's a <u>sample</u> you can look at and edit as well.

What do I wear?

- Friday evening, you may wear business casual or business dress as you choose.
- Saturday's training sessions are business casual/Rotary spirit wear.
- Saturday evening is our dress-up night for the President Elect Commissioning Ceremony! Business dress is encouraged.

• You've heard correctly! Plan to enjoy evening fellowship after the formal programs have ended for the night in a relaxed atmosphere and make some more Rotary memories!

What about expenses?

- The District is not able to reimburse expenses for lodging on Thursday night prior to District PETS. Our start time is designed to enable all presidents elect to make the drive to Delaware and arrive conveniently by 8:30 AM.
