







SHELTER BOX DAYCARE AND DAY CAMP:

Childcare for children ages 11 and under will be available during the following times:

- Friday 5:30 pm 10 pm \$30 per child
- Saturday 8 am 3:30 pm \$50 per child
- Saturday 5:30 pm 10 pm \$30 per child
- Full Camp Special \$90 per child

Meals are included in the Shelterbox Camp and Day Care Price. Kalahari is a family-friendly waterpark resort with a game room and a zoo as well and it is likely that your children are going to want to spend time at the park.
